This meeting is being held in Yakima, Washington at the Arboretum, and this meeting is held to discuss the proposed rule making for Chapters 463-28 463-47, 463-66. The time is five after 2:00. The clerk will take the roll.

8 Mr. Chairman, that our Assistant Attorney General, Kyle

11 is present. I would also note that comments are due close  
12 of business today or tomorrow?

13 MR. FIKSDAL: 5:00 p.m. at our office.

14 CHAIR LUCE: Are we allowing any latitude on  
15 that, Mr. Fiksdal?

16 MR. FIKSDAL: That's what the notice says.

17 CHAIR LUCE: I had a question from a member  
18 of the Northwest Energy Coalition that said they might  
19 submit comments one or two days late. I assume if  
20 comments are received by the end of the week, they're  
21 probably late for the record.

22 MR. FIKSDAL: It's up to the Council to  
23 decide whether they want to accept those comments or not.  
24 I don't think it's for me to decide.

25 CHAIR LUCE: But you wouldn't have any

2 MR. FIKSDAL: I wouldn't have any objection.

3 CHAIR LUCE: Thank you. We'll just be here  
4 and wait for someone to come.

5 MR. FIKSDAL: I think one thing I will note,  
6 Mr. Chairman, and for the record that the description that  
7 I gave regarding the three chapters that we are amending  
8 would be the same today as I mentioned yesterday at the  
9 hearing.

10 CHAIR LUCE: Thank you. I would note that  
11 we have made available summaries of our proposed rule  
12 making and actually the draft amendments for the public  
13 should the public attend.

14 We can go off the record.
