WHEREAS, under the date of May 18, 1979, the Aberdeen School District No. 5, Hoquiam School District No. 28, Montesano School District No. 66, Elma School District No. 68, Satsop School District No. 104, McCleary School District No. 65, Cosmopolis School District No. 99, and Oakville School District No. 400 filed a Petition for Binding Declaratory Ruling for a determination as to the purpose and scope of provisions of the Site Certification Agreement between the State of Washington and the Washington Public Power Supply System as to WPPSS Nos. 3 and 5 Nuclear Plants; and

WHEREAS, on June 11, 1979, Washington Public Power Supply System filed a Motion to Dismiss the Petition, stating the petition fails to demonstrate a justiciable controversy, and therefore the motion should be granted; and


WHEREAS, the Council has reviewed the petition and the motion it makes the following:

ORDER

Paragraph VI B.2. of the Site Certification Agreement between the State of Washington and the Washington Public Power Supply System for the nuclear electric generating facility in Grays Harbor, Washington, controls and the Washington Public Power Supply System is under a contractual duty to honor valid claims for reimbursement for all primary and secondary socioeconomic impacts with respect to any clearly anticipated net measurable financial burden on the school districts, no matter how small.


