(COUNCIL ORDER NO. 513, SEPTEMBER 13, 1976 IS HEREBY RESCINDED)

Having considered the provisions of Ch. 80.50 RCW and, specifically RCW 80.50.030, as well as its own rules set forth in Title 463 of the Washington Administrative Code and the contents of the application which indicate that the proposal could be sited in as many as ten different counties thereby necessitating the appointment of a large number of representatives from counties and ports pursuant to RCW 80.50.030 (4) and (6), the Council hereby adopts the following order governing participation by those representatives throughout the course of proceedings.

1. Only those members of the Council, as defined in RCW 80.50.030 (3), may participate in Council action and vote on matters of a general nature which do not directly concern the proposed site within any particular county or which affect all counties represented pursuant to RCW 80.50.030 (4) on an equal or nearly equal basis.
2. A county representative may participate in Council action and vote only at such times as the Council considers the proposed site for the county which he or she represents.
3. A Port District representative appointed pursuant to RCW 80.50.030 (6) may participate in Council discussion and deliberation only at such times as the Council considers the proposed site for the Port District which he/she represents but such representative shall not be entitled to vote.
