THIS MATTER Having come on regularly before the Energy Facility Site Evaluation Council at its regular meeting of October 27, 1980 upon petition by George R. Hethercutt, Jr., Town Attorney for the Town of Creston, for intervention in the proceedings relating to the application for site certification by the Washington Water Power Company, the Council having heard argument pertaining to the merits of intervention by the Town of Creston and the Council having duly voted to allow intervention by the Town of Creston,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY ORDERED By the Council that the Town of Creston, a municipal corporation of the fourth class in the State of Washington, is accorded status as an intervenor in the proceedings relating to the application for site certification of the Washington Water Power Creston Generating Station, as it relates to the construction of transmission facilities within the Town of Creston city limits, to those socioeconomic and environmental effects of construction that may impact the Town of Creston as a direct result of the Creston Generating Station, and to all other material factors directly affecting the interests of the Town of Creston. This accordance of intervention binds the intervenor to not unduly delay the proceeding or prejudice the rights of existing parties. Intervenors are given all rights of intervention according to Title 463 of the Washington Administrative Code.
