THIS MATTER Having come on regularly before the Energy Facility Site Evaluation Council at its regular meeting of June 22, 1981 upon petition by George R. Nethercutt, Jr., Attorney for Creston School Dist. No. 73, Davenport School Dist. No. 207 and Wilbur School Dist. No. 200, for intervention in the proceedings relating to the application for site certification by the Washington Water Power Company, the Council having heard argument pertaining to the merits of intervention by Creston School Dist. No. 73, Davenport School Dist. No. 207 and Wilbur School Dist. No. 200 and the Council having duly voted to allow intervention by Creston School Dist. No. 73, Davenport School Dist. No. 207, and Wilbur School Dist. No. 200.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY ORDERED By the Council that Creston School Dist. No. 73, Davenport School Dist. No. 207 and Wilbur School Dist. No. 200, all of which are municipal corporations in the State of Washington, are accorded status as intervenors in the proceedings relating to the application for site certification of the Washington Water Power Creston Generating Station, as it relates to those socioeconomic effects of construction and operation that may impact the Creston School Dist. No. 73, Davenport School Dist. No. 207 and Wilbur School Dist. No. 200. This accordance of intervention binds the intervenor to accept the record of the case, to abide by all decisions rendered herein and to not unduly delay the proceeding or prejudice the rights of existing parties. Intervenors are given all rights of intervention according to Title 463 of the Washington Administrative Code.
