
This matter came on regularly before the Energy Facility Site Evaluation Council (hereafter called Council) at its regular meeting of October 24, 1983. The Applicant, Trans Mountain Oil Pipe Line Corporation, (hereafter called Trans Mountain) requested the Council terminate further processing of the Application.

The Council considered this request at its regular meeting of November 28, 1983 and determined that certain actions must be completed such as records management and financial reconciliation before application processing can be terminated. The Council further determined that these actions should be complete by December 31, 1983.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY ORDERED by the Council effective December 31, 1983 that all processing of Application No. 79-1 will cease; that all Council Orders, Resolutions or other documents pertaining to Application No. 79-1 will be vacated; and that Application No. 79-1 is terminated.
