THESE MATTERS Having come on regularly before Patrick Biggs, Administrative Law Judge, for the Energy Facility Site Evaluation Council, at a prehearing conference held on October 19, 1981, which conference was held pursuant to notice duly given and was attended by Mr. Jerry Boyd, for the Applicant, Mr. Spencer Daniels for the Department of Transportation, Mr. Robert Mack for the Department of Ecology and Mr. George Nethercutt for the Town of Creston, the Town of Almira, the Town of Reardon, the Creston School District No. 73, the Davenport School District No. 207, the Wilbur School District No. 200 and the City of Davenport, and where these matters were discussed and arguments of all sides were considered;

1.
