

THESE MATTERS Having come on regularly before Patrick Biggs, Administrative Law Judge, for the Energy Facility Site Evaluation Council, at a prehearing conference held on October 19, 1981, which conference was held pursuant to notice duly given and was attended by Mr. Jerry Boyd, for the Applicant, Mr. Spencer Daniels for the Department of Transportation, Mr. Robert Mack for the Department of Ecology and Mr. George Nethercutt for the Town of Creston, the Town of Almira, the Town of Reardan, the Creston School District No. 73, the Davenport School District No. 207, the Wilbur School District No. 200 and the City of Davenport, and where these matters were discussed and arguments of all sides were considered;

NOW THEREFORE, The following orders are made:

1. Public hearings sponsored jointly by the Energy Facility Site Evaluation Council pursuant to RCW 80.50 and 34.04, and the United States Bureau of Reclamation, pursuant to the Environmental Policy Act, Section 102(2)(c), 1969, as amended, will be held on November 16, 1981, at 7:30 p.m., in Spokane, Washington, and November 18, 1981, at 7:30 p.m., in Creston, Washington. These hearings are the subject of notices dated October 12, 1981.
2. The intervenors' portion of the contested case will convene at the Memorial Hall, Davenport, Washington at 10:00 a.m., on November 17, 1981. Scheduling of testimony at Davenport has not specifically accounted for the final resolution of proposed stipulations and is, therefore, subject to adjustment for which advance notice may not be provided. Testimony is scheduled as follows:
