

RESOLUTION NO. 1-73

A Resolution of the Washington State Thermal Power Plant Site Evaluation Council according to the status of official application to the application of the Washington Public Power Supply System for site certification of WPPSS Nuclear Project No. 1 submitted to the Council on February 13, 1973.


WHEREAS, By letter dated October 16, 1972, from Mr. J. J. Stein, Managing Director of the Washington Public Power Supply System, advised the Council that it intended to apply for certification of a new nuclear steam supply system and topping turbine at its Hanford No. 1 steam electric plant on or before January 8, 1973; and

WHEREAS, At the regular Council meeting of February 13, 1973, the Washington Public Power Supply System did deliver to the Council thirty (30) copies of an application on 8½" x 11" sheets in a loose-leaf hard binder together with a letter of receipt for a check in the amount of twenty-five thousand (\$25,000.00) dollars from the State Treasurer, all as required by WAC 463-08-020 and RCW 80.50.070; and

WHEREAS, The Council and its consultant retained for this application, Mathematical Sciences Northwest, Inc., have conducted a preliminary examination of the application offered and found that it substantially complies with the Council's current "Guidelines for Applicants," chapter 463-12 WAC, and the Council's current "Rules of Practice," chapter 463-08 WAC;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, By the Thermal Power Plant Site Evaluation Council that the application of the Washington Public Power Supply System for certification of its WPPSS Nuclear Project No. 1, delivered to the Council on February 13, 1973, be accorded the status of an official application effective on the date of delivery to the Council and be designated as application 73-1.
