

Resolution No. 116

WHEREAS, the Washington Public Power Supply System has submitted a request in accordance with paragraph V.C.3. of the Site Certification Agreement for WNP 3 and 5 to the Energy Facility Site Evaluation Council for approval of the required qualifications for the consultant who will carry out all or any portion of the Environmental Monitoring Program set forth in Attachment IV to the Site Certification Agreement,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Energy Facility Site Evaluation Council that conduct of the construction phase monitoring studies is acceptable when administered by personnel with the experience and competence level identified in the following qualification summary:


- A. Have demonstrable satisfactory experience as an organization, or as individuals within the organization, in environmental monitoring,
- B. Have personnel on the staff experienced in the collection, preparation, and analysis of environmental samples,
- C. Have adequate analytical equipment readily available to perform all required analysis,
- D. Able to provide references for work preferably in areas closely related to this program,
- E. Provide the details of a quality assurance monitoring program,
- F. Have reasonable costs which reflect the level of effort required to accomplish the program competently,
- G. Commit sufficient personnel to assure the timely accomplishment of the program,
- H. Provide a responsive organization of personnel for the project,
- I. Demonstrate an understanding of Supply System needs and an explanation of how these needs would be met,
- J. Have the personnel and capability to provide the necessary reports in the format required by the Supply System, and
- K. Comply with all applicable conditions of the Site Certification Agreement.


