

Resolution No. 123

WHEREAS, General Condition 21 of the National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System waste discharge permit, Attachment 1 to the Site Certification Agreement for the Skagit Nuclear Power Project Units 1 and 2 provides in part that the permittee shall prepare and present to the Council the results of its investigation concerning pipelines laid in the bed of the Skagit River near the proposed diffuser site which may have been damaged or destroyed by the action of the river or objects carried therein; and

WHEREAS, the Puget Sound Power and Light Company through its project engineering company, Bechtel, Incorporated, did have prepared a study of two buried pipelines, a water line and a natural gas line, owned and operated by the Skagit County Public Utility District and the El Paso Natural Gas Company; and

WHEREAS, the report provides specific information on the pipelines' design, location and construction and identifies the major faults which caused the failure of the buried water line and identifies the reason for abandoning the buried natural gas line; and

WHEREAS, the report was received by the Council on May 26, 1977; and


WHEREAS, a Technical Committee was appointed with representatives from the Departments of Ecology, Fisheries, Highways and Natural Resources who reviewed the report and who did provide recommendations to the Council;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Energy Facility Site Evaluation Council accepts the report on Pipelines Laid in the Bed of the Skagit River Near the Proposed Diffuser Site, Skagit Nuclear Power Project, in satisfaction of the first portion of the NPDES Condition G 21.




