

Resolution No. 135

WHEREAS, The Energy Facility Site Evaluation Council issued Order #544 on February 14, 1978, directing the Washington Public Power Supply System to: "a) design and construct temporary facilities, subject to the approval of the Washington Energy Facility Site Evaluation Council, capable of producing 11,100 pounds of fall chinook salmon per year for four years from the date the facilities are completed and made available to the Washington Department of Fisheries; b) to obtain adequate land and water for the construction and operation of such facilities; and c) to pay for all operational expenses incurred by the Washington Department of Fisheries reasonably necessary for the operation and maintenance of such facilities", and

WHEREAS, The Council Order further directed that the facility be completed and in operation in time for first release of salmon fry in 1979, and

WHEREAS, The Supply System is negotiating the necessary land and water agreements with Grant County PUD #1, and further has retained the services of consultants to design the facilities, and

WHEREAS, The Supply System and the consultants have developed certain conceptual criteria that will govern the configuration and sizing of the facility, and has met with the Compliance Monitoring Committee for discussion and evaluation of the criteria, and


WHEREAS, Agreement on the criteria exists between the Committee and the Supply System;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED That the Energy Facility Site Evaluation Council concurs in the acceptability of the criteria, as further identified in Attachment I, and finds the criteria is sufficient to produce 11,100 pounds of fall chinook fry per year, @ 75-90 fish per pound, and instructs the Supply System to proceed with design based on the approved criteria.



FISH CULTURE FACILITIES REQUIRED BY EFSEC ORDER NO. 544

ITEM	CRITERIA
Water Supply for hatchery	0.2 cfs
Water Supply for rearing	6.0 cfs
Modification to hatchery	Isolate 10 stacks
Rearing - first feed	4 temporary raceways (8x83x3) water depth
Rearing - final	Modify adult holding pond - 4 ft.
Food Storage	
Emergency Back-up	Either flow thru tank (1 volume) or diesel generator
Discharge	Existing discharge pipe from adult holding pond to river
