

Resolution No. 136

WHEREAS, At the applicant's request the Council by motion placed the Trans Mountain Oil Pipe Line Corporation application in inactive status on November 28, 1977; and

WHEREAS, The applicant on March 13, 1978, through its attorney Anthony Paul, expressed intent to withdraw its application; and

WHEREAS, Written notice of withdrawal, to be effective March 31, 1978, was received in the Council offices on March 17, 1978, signed by Mr. K. L. Hall, President of Trans Mountain Oil Pipe Line Corporation;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED By the Energy Facility Site Evaluation Council that the Council acknowledges receipt of the applicant's notice of withdrawal; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED By the Energy Facility Site Evaluation Council that all processing of the application shall be terminated effective March 31, 1978; and


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED By the Energy Facility Site Evaluation Council that all Council actions currently in force relative to the application are hereby rescinded, effective March 31, 1978; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED That all unobligated funds of the applicant on deposit against independent consultant fees and application processing costs shall be returned following the termination of processing.


