

RESOLUTION NO. 156

WHEREAS, the Washington Public Power Supply System did file with the State of Washington Energy Facility Site Evaluation Council on August 21, 1978 a Notice of and Application for Modification of Certification Agreement and NPDES Permit requesting in part deletion of provisions suspending authorization to withdraw intake water when river flow falls below 550 cfs or modification to authorize intake at lower flow levels, and

WHEREAS, the Washington Public Power Supply System has determined during its investigation and preparation in support of this modification request that the base flow restriction of 550 cfs does not in the great majority of river flow years so substantially effect plant operational scheduling and availability as to meet the "overriding public interest" standard contained in RCW 90.54.020(3)(a), and


WHEREAS, the Washington Public Power Supply System did file with the Energy Facility Site Evaluation Council on August 16, 1979 a Motion for Voluntary Dismissal of Request to Modify Certification Agreement, and

WHEREAS, the Energy Facility Site Evaluation Council having reviewed said Motion concurs with its intent;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Energy Facility Site Evaluation Council that the Washington Public Power Supply System's Application for Modification of the Site Certification Agreement for Nuclear Projects Nos. 3 and 5 filed August 21, 1978 is dismissed without prejudice.
