

RESOLUTION NO. 158

WHEREAS, Section G25 of NPDES Permit No. WA-002496-1 for WPPSS Nuclear Projects 3 and 5 requires that the permittee obtain Energy Facility Site Evaluation Council approval of an Oil and Hazardous Material Prevention Containment and Countermeasure Plan prior to the on-site storage of oil and hazardous materials, and

WHEREAS, the Council approved the plan and did document approval of a revised plan in Resolution No. 149, dated June 11, 1979, and

WHEREAS, it was found necessary to supplement the approved plan with a new estimate of quantities for oil and fuels,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Energy Facility Site Evaluation Council approves the attached Supplement to the Oil Spill Prevention and Countermeasure Plan subject to the following conditions:

At such time as the permittee desires to store materials different from those found in the approved plan, or in substantially greater quantities than those given in the attached supplement, the permittee shall provide the Council with a new supplement and shall increase containment, fire prevention, and clean up elements commensurate with such increases in inventory.
