RESOLUTION NO. 178

WHEREAS, During the period of August 22 - 29, 1977 a rain storm of unexpected intensity caused serious soil erosion on the Washington Public Power Supply System's Nuclear Projects Nos. 3 and 5 construction site resulting in sediment discharge to creeks draining into the Chehalis River; and

WHEREAS, These creeks contribute to spawning or rearing of steelhead and cutthroat trout stocks of the Chehalis Basin; and

WHEREAS, Article IV.D.1 of the Site Certification Agreement for the WPPSS Nuclear Projects Nos. 3 and 5 states that the:

"Supply System agrees to provide replacement and/or compensation, as established by the Council, for any wildlife, fish, or other aquatic life or ecosystem damage or loss caused by construction or operation of the project;" and

WHEREAS, The Council did resolve in Resolution No. 147 of October 9, 1978, Paragraph I that:

"The Supply System is in no way relieved by means of this resolution of any losses to aquatic resources and/or fishing opportunities which have occurred to date or may occur as a result of erosion originating at the construction site or access roads thereto;" and

WHEREAS, the Washington State Department of Game (WDG) has pursued an assessment of losses and has submitted a report to the Council through the Monitoring Committee via transmittal dated February 1, 1980; and


WHEREAS, The information has been reviewed and evaluated by the Committee and the following category of specific loss has been concurred in by the members:

1. Lost recreation days on Chehalis River because of silt	\$3,958
2. Loss of production in creeks	3,292
3. Washington Department of Game personnel costs	2,500
4. Rearing and planting of replacement fry	<u>3,250</u>
	13,000

- (2) The Department of Game will provide to the Council the dates and estimates of fry planted in the three streams associated with erosion damage and/or production losses. Costs associated with lost recreation or production shall be applied to the Chehalis Basin sport fishery program.


