Resolution No. 197

WHEREAS, Section G25 of NPDES Permit No. WA-002496-1 (Attachment III of the Site Certification Agreement) for WPPSS Nuclear Projects Nos. 3 and 5 requires that the permittee obtain EFSEC approval of an Oil and Hazardous Material Prevention Containment and Countermeasure Plan prior to the on-site storage of oil and hazardous materials; and

WHEREAS, Following review of the plan the Council did approve the plan and did document approval in Resolution No. 120 dated May 9, 1977; and

WHEREAS, It was found necessary to revise the plan and the revised plan was approved in Resolution No. 142 dated May 3, 1978; and

WHEREAS, It was found necessary to make further revisions to the plan and the revised plan was approved in Resolution No. 149 dated June 11, 1979; and

WHEREAS, It was subsequently necessary to supplement the approved plan with a new estimate of quantities of oil and fuels documented by EFSEC Resolution No. 158 dated October 29, 1979; and

WHEREAS, Changing site management required further revisions to the plan and the revised plan was submitted by the Supply System letter dated August 6, 1981 and identified as PSP-EM-3-2, Rev. 0;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That Energy Facility Site Evaluation Council Resolution No. 149 dated June 11, 1979 and Resolution No. 158 dated October 29, 1979 are hereby rescinded and that the revised Oil Spill Prevention and Countermeasure Plan is hereby approved in accordance with General Condition G25 of NPDES Permit No. WA-002496-1, subject to the following conditions:

1. The plan is approved for the duration of construction activities on site to minimize the potential for, and effect of, oil and hazardous material spills;
2. Only those categories of materials listed in Attachment 2 of the subject Oil Spill Prevention and Countermeasure Plan are authorized by this Resolution to be stored on the construction site; and

3. At such time as the permittee desires to store materials different from those found in the subject plan or in substantially greater quantities, the permittee shall supplement the subject plan.


