

RESOLUTION NO. 207

CLOSED OUT BY
COUNCIL MOTION
13 SEPT 82

WHEREAS, The Washington Public Power Supply System did request during the Council meeting of July 26, 1982 that the Council reinstate the turbidity waiver given in EFSEC Resolution No. 167 for construction of the barge unloading facility and supplemental dredging; and

WHEREAS, The Council has reviewed the request and recognized that short-term increases in turbidity can be expected from dredging and desilting operations;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That a turbidity waiver is hereby granted for supplemental dredging and desilting operations associated with the barge unloading facility, subject to the following provisions:

1. Supplemental dredging at the barge slip shall take place during the period August 2 through 7, 1982, and will take no more than four (4) days to complete.
2. No discharge of visible oil or grease shall be permitted to reach any receiving water.
3. All reasonable measures to reduce turbidity shall be taken.
4. Spoil materials shall be spread in such a manner as to minimize adverse effects on the passage of flood flows and/or reentry into the Chehalis River.
5. The water quality criteria set forth in WAC 173.20.030(2)(c)(vi) as for turbidity is hereby modified for the period beginning 0100 hours August 2, 1982, and terminating 2400 hours August 7, 1982, in accordance with the following condition:

Sampling of the Chehalis River upstream and downstream of the barge slip shall be done daily during dredging and desilting operations. Sampling results shall be promptly reported to the Council. Analyses shall be for turbidity and settleable solids.

6. The Department of Ecology Inspector (R. Stanley) shall be notified of the exact schedule for dredging and desilting operations.
