

RESOLUTION No. 218

WHEREAS, the Site Certification Agreement for WNP 3 and 5 includes the following condition:

"VI.A. Project Visitation and Recreation

1. Supply System agrees to provide visitor information facilities for the project." and,

WHEREAS, during the project's period of construction, the Supply System has offered an extensive program of visitor information services, including a staffed visitor information center, escorted tours, and speakers visiting schools and organizations, and,

WHEREAS, the Supply System has now encountered significant difficulty in securing adequate and continuing financing for WNP-3, and

WHEREAS, such difficulties have lead the Supply System Executive Board to move on July 8, 1983 to suspend construction on WNP-3 for at least three years, and

WHEREAS, the lack of construction activity and the severe lack of funds conspire to make it reasonable that visitor information services be sharply reduced during a period of suspended construction,


NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Council finds that the Supply System has fulfilled Condition VI.A.1 of the WNP-3/5 Site Certification Agreement through July 11, 1983, and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that compliance through a reduced staff at an alternate location is hereby approved for 36 months from this date or until construction resumes, whichever occurs first. For purposes of this resolution "construction resumes" shall mean when total on-site employment reaches 1000 persons.
