

RESOLUTION NO. 227

WHEREAS, Condition G-29 of the WNP-3/5 NPDES Permit requires that thorough bioassays be performed to determine sensitivities of resident salmonids to copper and zinc; and

WHEREAS, The Council did through Resolution Numbers 165, 189, 192, and 202 grant approval for various phases of the bioassay program; and

WHEREAS, By letter dated March 27, 1984, the Council did approve the final report on the bioassays;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, By the Energy Facility Site Evaluation Council that Council Resolution Numbers 165, 189, 192, and 202 are hereby closed out and shall no longer be considered active requirements.
