

RESOLUTION NO. 239

WHEREAS, Section I of Attachment I of the WNP-2 Site Certification Agreement (SCA) and, similarly, Section I of Attachment II of the WNP-1/4 SCA state, "The Environmental Monitoring Program will be flexible and may be modified with concurrence of the Council as detailed information is acquired from the program."; and

WHEREAS, V.C.4. of the WNP-1/4 SCA states, ". . . The Project Monitoring Program will be coordinated with the Monitoring Program of WPPSS Nuclear Project No. 2 inasmuch as the programs are the same in purpose, design and monitoring area."; and

WHEREAS, Section I of Attachment I of the WNP-2 SCA states, "This Environmental Monitoring Program is part of a single integrated program for monitoring the preliminary, preoperational, and operational phases of three nuclear power plants (WNP-2 and WNP-1 and 4) planned for the site."; and

WHEREAS, Council Resolution No. 193 approved Revision No. 2 to the WNP-2 Environmental Monitoring Program, Attachment I, adopting the terrestrial monitoring component of the Environmental Monitoring Program for WNP-2 site; and

WHEREAS, Council Resolution No. 194 approved Revision No. 1 to the WNP-1/4 Environmental Monitoring Program, Attachment II, adopting the terrestrial monitoring component of the Environmental Monitoring Program for WNP-1/4 site; and

WHEREAS, Council Resolution No. 214 (Amended) approved Revision No. 2 to the WNP-2 Environmental Monitoring Program, Attachment I, Sections IV and V of the SCA for the aquatic life program and water quality monitoring program; and

WHEREAS, By letter of August 11, 1987, the Supply System did submit for Council review a draft report titled, Review Of The Environmental Monitoring Program For WNP-2 With Recommendations For Design Of Continuing Studies; and

WHEREAS, The Council has reviewed the proposed modifications for long-term aquatic, terrestrial and water quality monitoring programs and finds that the recommended changes to the Environmental Monitoring Program have been found to be reasonable and satisfactory for the purposes of environmental monitoring and will adequately protect or further reduce impacts on the environment;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That the Energy Facility Site Evaluation Council hereby approves the proposed attached Revision No. 3, Review Of The Environmental Monitoring Program For WNP-2 And Recommendations For Design Of Continuing Studies dated September 3, 1987 to the WNP-2 Environmental Monitoring Program, Attachment I, Sections IV, V, and VI of the SCA (Revision No. 2 to the WNP-1/4 Environmental Monitoring Program, Attachment II, Sections IV, V and VI of the SCA).
