

RESOLUTION NO. 243

WHEREAS, The Energy Facility Site Evaluation Council (Council) has adopted rules directing applicants and certificate holders to formulate plans for site restoration, effective March 11, 1987; and

WHEREAS, The Washington Public Power Supply System (Supply System) submitted a draft initial plan for restoration of the site of Washington Nuclear Project No. 1, (WNP-1) Hanford Reservation, to the Council for review pursuant to rule and the draft was commented upon, revised, and resubmitted to the Council; and

WHEREAS, The site restoration plan for WNP-1 as revised does: 1) address the many issues of concern to the Council, such as the funding of site restoration activities; 2) recognize that the Council will ultimately direct the appropriate level of site restoration; and 3) recognize that restoration activities relating to noncontaminated structures can occur independently of the decommissioning activities relating to radioactive components; and

WHEREAS, WNP-1 is located on a common site with Washington Nuclear Project No. 4 (WNP-4), a terminated project, and both projects are licensed by the state of Washington under a single Site Certification Agreement; and

WHEREAS, The Supply System has requested that the Council defer consideration of the initial and detailed restoration plans for portions of the site occupied by WNP-4 because: 1) no funds are available for site restoration activities; 2) there are active salvage programs underway at the project; and 3) a final determination on the level of site restoration should await a decision as to resumption of construction or termination on the twinned project, WNP-1; and


WHEREAS, The Supply System is responsible for restoration of the entire common site which is licensed by the Council; and

WHEREAS, The Council will require review of the initial WNP-1 site restoration plan at least every five years pursuant to Council rule;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That the Council hereby approves the initial site restoration plan for WNP-1 but that final action on this common site is contingent upon approval of an initial restoration plan for those portions relating to WNP-4.
