

RESOLUTION NO. 247

WHEREAS, The Energy Facility Site Evaluation Council (Council) has adopted rules directing applicants and certificate holders to formulate plans for site restoration, effective March 11, 1987; and

WHEREAS, The Washington Water Power Company (WWP) submitted a draft initial plan for restoration of the Creston Generating Station (CGS) to the Council for review, pursuant to rule, and the draft was commented upon, revised and resubmitted to the Council by letter dated May 22, 1989; and

WHEREAS, The Site Restoration Plan for the CGS does: 1) address restoration of the developments on and for the site in the event the project is terminated prior to plant construction; 2) provide initial plans for restoration of the site and long-term monitoring of wastes produced during operation; and 3) provide that the Council will be provided the funding mechanism for decommissioning and site restoration prior to the plant's operation; and

WHEREAS, The Council is concerned that funds will be available for site restoration in the event construction of the project is terminated prior to plant operation; and

WHEREAS, The Council will require review of these plans at least every five years, pursuant to Council rule;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That the Council hereby approves the initial Site Restoration Plan for the CGS, subject to review and amendment as provided in the Council rules, and subject to approval, prior to the start of construction, of a plan for site restoration, and funding of such restoration in the event of termination of construction prior to operation.
