

RESOLUTION NO. 262

WHEREAS, Chapter 463-42 WAC Procedure--Guidelines-Application for Site Certification sets forth the Energy Facility Site Evaluation Council's guidelines for preparation of applications for energy facility site certification; and

WHEREAS, WAC 463-42-012 General Organization--Index provides that applications for site certification, except as otherwise approved by the Council and those for nuclear power plants, be organized in the same order as the guidelines; and

WHEREAS, The Trans Mountain Pipe Line Company LTD., by letter dated February 26, 1992, asked the Council to approve an application format for the Low Point project where the introductory section is organized according to the Chapter 463-42 WAC guidelines, and the remainder of the application uses a format following the State Environmental Policy Act (SEPA) guidelines; and

WHEREAS, The Council finds the proposed format may be more familiar to local, state and federal agencies, and may help in the coordination of application review and development of a joint state/federal Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) between the Council and the Army Corp of Engineers; and

WHEREAS, The Council has previously accepted and successfully reviewed one or more applications having formats other than that described in the Council guidelines:

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, The Energy Facility Site Evaluation Council hereby authorizes Trans Mountain Pipe Line Company LTD. to submit their Low Point application in the format they have proposed, subject to the following conditions:


- 1) The introductory section will be organized following the Council guidelines in Chapter 463-42 WAC and will clearly reference by section and page, the corresponding parts of the application addressing the subject matter in detail.
- 2) Other than the introductory section, the Trans Mountain Low Point application can be organized in the same manner as outlined in the SEPA guidelines contained in Chapter 197-11 WAC.
- 3) The Trans Mountain Low Point application shall thoroughly and completely address all the subjects as required by Chapter 463-42 WAC.
