

RESOLUTION NO. 4-74

A Resolution of the Washington State Thermal Power Plant Site Evaluation Council according to the status of official application to the application of the Puget Sound Power & Light Company for site certification of its Skagit Nuclear Project submitted to the Council on March 28, 1974.


WHEREAS, By letter of January 18, 1973, amended by subsequent letters dated June 11, 1973, November 1, 1973, and January 4, 1974, from Mr. W. J. Ferguson, Director of Major Project Construction, the Puget Sound Power & Light Company advised the Council that it intended to apply for certification of a proposed stationary nuclear power plant to be located approximately five miles east of Sedro Woolley in Skagit County; and

WHEREAS, On March 28, 1974, the Puget Sound Power & Light Company did deliver to the Council thirty (30) copies of an application on 8½" x 11" sheets in looseleaf hard binders together with a cashier's check in the amount of twenty-five thousand (\$25,000.00) dollars payable to the State Treasurer, all as required by WAC 463-08-020 and RCW 80.50.070; and

WHEREAS, The Council has conducted a preliminary examination of the application offered and found that it substantially complies with the Council's current "Guidelines For Applicants," chapter 463-12 WAC, and the Council's current "Rules of Practice," chapter 463-08 WAC;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, By the Thermal Power Plant Site Evaluation Council that the application of the Puget Sound Power & Light Company for certification of its Skagit Nuclear Power Project delivered to the Council on March 28, 1974, be accorded the status of an official application effective on the date of delivery to the Council and be designated as Application No. 74-1.
