

RESOLUTION NO. 6-74

A Resolution of the Washington State Thermal Power Plant Site Evaluation Council according to the status of official application to the application of the Washington Public Power Supply System for site certification of WPPSS Nuclear Project No. 1 submitted to the Council on May 29, 1974.

WHEREAS, By letter dated May 17, 1974, from Mr. J. J. Stein, its Managing Director, the Washington Public Power Supply System requested that the Council waive the requirement of WAC 463-08-023 that "notice of intent" to file an application be submitted in writing at least 90 days in advance of the filing of an application as it would apply to its Nuclear Project No. 1 relocated at a site adjacent to the site for its Nuclear Project No. 2 (Application No. 71-1); and


WHEREAS, Portions of the anticipated application will be the same as Applications No. 71-1 and 73-1 previously considered by the Council, the Council determined that the requested waiver would not delay the initiation of the processing of the application and, by motion unanimously approved at its May 27, 1974, regular meeting, did grant the requested waiver; and

WHEREAS, On May 29, 1974, the Washington Public Power Supply System did deliver to the Council thirty (30) copies of an application on 8½" x 11" sheets in looseleaf hard binders together with a check in the amount of twenty-five thousand (\$25,000.00) dollars payable to the State Treasurer, all as required by WAC 463-08-020 and RCW 80.50.070; and

WHEREAS, The Council has conducted a preliminary examination of the application offered and found that it substantially complies with the Council's current "Guidelines for Applicants," chapter 463-12 WAC, and the Council's current "Rules of Practice," chapter 463-08 WAC;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, By the Thermal Power Plant Site Evaluation Council that the application of the Washington Public Power Supply System for certification of its relocated WPPSS Nuclear Project No. 1, delivered to the Council on May 29, 1974, be accorded the status of an official application effective on the date of delivery to the Council and be designated as Application No. 74-2.
