Notice of Public Meeting and Comment Opportunity

Cherry Point Cogeneration Project

You are invited to attend a Public Meeting to learn about proposed changes to the Cherry Point Cogeneration Project and to submit comments.

When: Tuesday, October 3, 2006, from 6:30 p.m. to 8:30 p.m.

What is this meeting about?

In June 2006, BP West Coast Products LLC (BP) requested that the Energy Facility Site Evaluation Council (EFSEC) revise the Cherry Point Cogeneration Project Site Certification Agreement (SCA). The Cherry Point Project was approved by Governor Locke in December 2004, as a 720 MW natural gas fired electrical cogeneration facility. BP has requested that the SCA be amended as follows:

- Allow BP the flexibility to proceed with construction of the entire 720 MW project, or construct the facility in two phases;
- Allow the use of either GE or Siemens combustion turbines;
- Allow BP to use treated refinery fuel gas in the Heat Recovery Steam Generator duct burners instead of natural gas;
- Allow BP to use aqueous rather than anhydrous ammonia for control of nitrogen oxide (NOx) air emissions;
- Allow BP to lengthen the construction period from 27 to 33 months;
- Construct the project using the International Building Code of 2003 rather than the Uniform Building Code of 1997;
- Allow BP to determine during the final project design whether stack silencers are required to meet noise limits established in the SCA;
- Change the description of the Ferndale Pipeline compressor facilities found in the SCA.

This Public Meeting will be an opportunity for you to meet with BP and EFSEC staff to find out about these changes.
