

Responses to Comments in Letter 55 from Michael Bozzo, Bellingham Resident

Note: The responses listed below are numbered to correspond to the numbers shown in the right-hand margin of the preceding comment letter.

1. The 115 kV power lines that run through Whatcom County are no longer part of the project. Only the 230 kV line to Canada is included in the project.
2. Bald eagles tend to perch and nest in large trees. The primary concern with bald eagles for this project was the crossing of the Nooksack River. Since that action is no longer being considered, impacts on potential bald eagle habitat are considered minor. Only one large, mature tree would be removed during construction for the 230 kV electrical line to Canada.
3. The 115 kV power lines that run through Whatcom County are no longer part of the project. Only the 230 kV line to Canada is included in the project.
