I. INTRODUCTION

Applicant Tesoro-Savage Petroleum Terminal LLC, d/b/a Vancouver Energy (“Vancouver Energy”) filed a Motion for to Dismiss issues 15, 20, 49, 50, 51, 52, 53, and 66 in their entirety, and portions of issues 7, 12, 14, 18, 19, 39, 45, 64, 67, and 68 (“Rail Operation Issues”) identified in the Order Clarifying EFSEC’s Process, Modifying Dispositive Motion Deadline, Summarizing Preliminary Issues, and Setting Hearing Dates (Feb. 3, 2016) that ask EFSEC to address rail transportation and safety generally along interstate rail lines leading to the proposed Vancouver Energy Distribution Terminal.
