RE: Docket No. EF-131590, Application No. 2013-01 to urge the Washington Energy Facility Site Evaluation Council (EFSEC) to assess the full environmental and public safety impact of the joint Tesoro-Savage proposal to turn the Port of Vancouver into a major crude oil export terminal.

Historically, we didn't assess the impact of shipping terminals and railroads. So our history is littered with train accidents and polluted cost lines. Washington does appear to gain much in exporting oil by rail and barge. And the risks seem great.
