Overview

Rezone has been granted, remaining work is on hold.

Project manager for the preparation of revisions to the existing Site Certification Agreement to add a second 660 MW power plant to the permitted gas-fired electrical generation project. Requested revisions have been placed on hold by the applicant (Duke Energy) and the project has been sold to a new owner (Invenergy).

Chehalis Generation Facility, Revisions to Site Certification Agreement, Chehalis, Washington. Project manager for the preparation of revisions to the existing Site Certification Agreement. Project revisions to the gas-fired electrical generation project include increasing electrical output to 520 MW and changing from a wet cooling system to an air (dry) cooling system. Requested revisions were approved by the Energy Facility Site Evaluation Council.

Chehalis Generation Facility, EFSEC Application, Lewis County, Washington. Project manager for the preparation of an application to the Washington State EFSEC for proposed 460 MW Chehalis Generation Facility in Lewis County, Washington.
