Members of the Energy Facility Site Evaluation Council will tour of the Whistling Ridge Energy Project site on Thursday, May 7, 2009. The tour will leave the Underwood Community Center at 10:00 a.m. and proceed to various locations in and around the proposed site. The purpose of the site visit is to view the proposed site, the proposed location of facilities on the site, and the immediate environs of the site. The tour is expected to last until approximately 12:00 noon.

The site visit is open to members of the public to the extent not disruptive of its purpose, but they must provide their own transportation.

Communication among tour participants should be limited to identification of the location of the site and proposed facilities. In anticipation of future adjudicative proceedings¹, communication about the project or its facilities consisting of advocacy or project details beyond those necessary to understand the location of the site and proposed facilities may be considered *ex parte* communications and are forbidden; any inadvertent communications of that sort must be disclosed on the record of those proceedings and other parties must be given the opportunity to respond. See, RCW 34.04.455.

No Energy Facility Site Evaluation Council business will be transacted and there will be no final action² items.

² Action" means the transaction of the official business of a public agency by a governing body including but not limited to receipt of public testimony, deliberations, discussions, considerations, reviews, evaluations, and final actions. "Final action" means a collective positive or negative decision, or an actual vote by a majority of the members of a governing body when sitting as a body or entity, upon a motion, proposal, resolution, order, or ordinance. RCW 42.30020(3).
