- 1 1. Mr. Kiive is the Vice President of Operations for Tidewater Barge Lines. He has served
2 in that position for over ten years. Kiive Dep. at 5.
3
- 4 2. Mr. Kiive also serves on the Board of Directors for Tidewater Barge Lines. Kiive Dep. at
5 13. He served on the Board of Directors when a group of investors organized by Sterling
6 Ventures purchased Tidewater Barge Lines, Tidewater Terminal Company, Sundial
7 Marine and the Crystal Dolphin (all Tidewater entities). Kiive Dep. at 12-14.
8
- 9 3. Mr. Kiive testified that during the course of the sale of Tidewater Barge Lines, he was
10 unaware of any discussions regarding whether it would be necessary to lay off or
11 terminate employees if the Cross Cascade Pipeline were approved. Kiive Dep. at 18-19.
12
- 13 4. In connection with preparation for this proceeding, Mr. Kiive provided “estimates of
14 impact” to a third-party consultant whose name he does not remember. Mr. Kiive does
15 not remember the specifics of the “estimates of impact” which he provided. Kiive Dep.
16 at 34-35, 47.
17
- 18 5. Tidewater Barge Lines owns and operates 107 dry product barges and 10 petroleum
19 barges. Kiive Dep. at 51.
20
- 21 6. True and correct copies of the referenced pages from the deposition transcript of Mr.
22 Kiive are attached hereto.
