STIPULATIONS BETWEEN OLYMPIC
PIPELINE AND DEPARTMENT OF
TRANSPORTATION

I. PARTIES

Olympic Pipeline Co. (OPL) has filed an application for a Site Certification Agreement (SCA) from the Energy Facility Site Evaluation Council (EFSEC), Application No. 96-1, to construct and operate a refined petroleum products pipeline (Project).

The Washington State Department of Transportation (WSDOT) is a party to the site certification adjudication before the EFSEC.

II. PURPOSE AND INTENT

OPL and WSDOT (collectively the Parties) have been involved in discussions and negotiations related to the Project's potential effect upon portions of the state's transportation system for which WSDOT is responsible. Through this Agreement, WSDOT and OPL set forth the obligations and restrictions related to the state highway crossings, installation in the Homestead Valley Road, and mitigation for transportation impacts caused by the Kittitas terminal that the Parties intend to have incorporated into the SCA as conditions for the Project should EFSEC recommend that the Project be certified.

III. STIPULATIONS

WSDOT has reviewed the impact on the state's transportation system caused by the state highway crossings, installation in the Homestead Valley Road, and the Kittitas terminal and has determined that these aspects of the Project will not adversely impact the state's transportation system provided that the Project is built as described in the amended application and the obligations, restrictions, and conditions in the stipulations attached as Appendix 1 are met. This stipulation does not address issues related to the proposed attachment to the I-90 Vantage Bridge, although OPL and WSDOT continue to discuss the Vantage Bridge issues.

IV . WITHDRAWAL OF OBJECTIONS

Based on the Notice of Construction and the commitment and restrictions made by OPL in the amended application for a SCA and in these stipulations, WSDOT stipulates to the withdrawal of State transportation system issues from the adjudicative hearing.
