> All of the Transmission contracts should have the following Language:

> Hazardous Material, Toxic Substance, and Petroleum Product Identification:
> If a hazardous material, toxic substance, or petroleum product is
> discovered, and may pose an immediate threat to human health or the
> environment, than the Contractor shall notify the COTR immediately. Other
> conditions such as large dump sites, drums of unknown substances,
> suspicious odors, stained soil, etc.. shall also be reported immediately
> to the COTR. The COTR will coordinate with the appropriate personnel
> within Bonneville. The contractor shall not disturb such conditions until
> the COTR has given the notice to proceed.
