Requests Regarding the Whistling Ridge Energy Project Site Certification Agreement

In September 2023, Whistling Ridge Energy, LLC submitted requests to the Energy Facility Site Evaluation Council (EFSEC or Council) on two matters pertaining to the Site Certification Agreement (SCA) for the Whistling Ridge Energy Project. The first request seeks approval from the Council of a transfer of control of the certificate holder, Whistling Ridge Energy, LLC from SDS Lumber Co. to Twin Creek Timber LLC (TCT). The second request seeks an amendment of the SCA to extend its term to November 2026. EFSEC invites you to participate in its consideration of these requests. The Council, as the state agency responsible for regulating Whistling Ridge Energy Project, will hold two separate, but consecutive, hybrid public hearings on May 16, 2024, from 5 pm to 9 pm to provide an opportunity for citizens, stakeholders, and interested persons or organizations to receive information and to provide comments on each of the two requests.

Public Hearing on Two Requests: May 16, 2024, from 5 PM – 9 PM or until the last speaker whichever comes first: Pursuant to WAC 463-66-100 and WAC 463-66-030, EFSEC proposes to hold two public hearings on the evening of May 16, 2024. Attendance is available in-person and virtually online. During the hearings the prospective Certificate Holder will present its requests and the Council will hear public comments on the requests for the Council's consideration. Separate sessions will be provided for the Council to receive comments pertinent to each of the two requests.

The first request is to approve the transfer of control of the SCA. This hearing will begin at 5 pm and end at 7 pm or when the last speaker or heard, whichever occurs first. No later than 30 minutes after the conclusion of the first hearing, the Council will consider the second request.

The second request is to approve an extension to the term of the SCA. This hearing will continue until 9 pm or until the last speaker is heard, whichever occurs first. Speakers may have limited minutes to provide comments, and any additional comments will be directed to be submitted

online or by postal mail. Duration of speaking time will be announced at the meeting, depending on the number of speakers signed up, to allow as many commenters as possible.

Public Comment: Public comment will be accepted during the public informational hearings' separate sessions.
