SUBJECT: Proposed Tesoro-Savage Joint Venture

On August 29, 2013, the Washington State Energy Facility Site Evaluation Council (EFSEC) received an application to site a petroleum terminal at the Port of Vancouver, in Clark County. Tesoro-Savage, a joint venture submitted their application to construct and operate the proposed Tesoro-Savage Vancouver Energy Distribution Terminal, a crude-by-rail unloading and marine loading facility.

EFSEC is beginning its review process of the Tesoro-Savage Terminal as required by Chapter 80.50 Revised Code of Washington and Title 463 Washington Administrative Code. Under WAC 197-11-938 EFSEC is the lead SEPA agency for this project.
