Order No. 877, dated September 5, 2019, suspended site certification for the Columbia Solar Project (Columbia Solar) and included requirements in order for reinstatement of certification. On November 25, 2019 at a special open meeting the Energy Facility Site Evaluation Council (EFSEC or Council) approved TUUSSO Energy's (TUUSSO) written request for reinstatement of site certification for Columbia Solar. A copy of signed Order No. 878 reinstating the Columbia Solar certification is enclosed for your records.

As you know, the reinstatement of certification is subject to the condition that the EFSEC Manager work with the certificate holder to develop a recommended adjustment of the amount of the deposit to be required by the Council under RCW 80.50.071(2)(a).
