

RESOLUTION NO. 244

WHEREAS, The Energy Facility Site Evaluation Council (Council) has adopted rules directing applicants and certificate holders to formulate plans for site restoration, effective March 11, 1987; and

WHEREAS, The Washington Public Power Supply System (Supply System) submitted a draft initial plan for restoration of the site of the Washington Nuclear Project No. 2 (WNP-2) to the Council for review, pursuant to rule, and the draft was commented upon, revised, and resubmitted to the Council; and


WHEREAS, The site restoration plan for WNP-2 does: 1) address the many issues of concern to the Council, such as the funding of site restoration activities; 2) recognize that the Council will ultimately direct the appropriate level of site restoration; and 3) recognize that restoration activities relating to noncontaminated structures can occur independently of the decommissioning activities relating to radioactive components; and

WHEREAS, The Council will require review of these plans at least every five years, pursuant to Council rule;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That the Council hereby approves the initial site restoration plan for WNP-2, subject to review and amendment as provided in the Council rules.
