Procedural Background and Party Positions:

On July 31, 2023 the Confederated Tribes and Bands of the Yakama Nation ("Yakama Nation") filed a *Motion to Supplement the Record* with transcripts of discovery depositions taken of three Washington Department of Fish and Wildlife employees, as follows:

- Michael Ritter (deposition taken on May 31, 2023)
- James Watson (deposition taken on July 14, 2023)
- Jason Fidorra (deposition taken on July 20, 2023)

On August 4, 2023 Tri-Cities C.A.R.E.S. ("TCC") filed *TCC's Motion to Supplement Record* (*David Kobus Deposition*). TCC's sought to include in the record the discovery deposition taken of David Kobus on July 21, 2023. Mr. Kobus is the Project Manager for Scout Clean Energy on the Horse Heaven Hills Wind and Solar Farm Project.

On August 4, 2023, Administrative Law Judge ("ALJ") Adam E. Torem conducted a fourth prehearing conference in this matter. During the conference, all parties verbally stipulated to no opposition to Yakama Nation's and TCC's motions to supplement the record.

Decision:

The Yakama Nation's *Motion to Supplement the Record* and *TCC's Motion to Supplement Record* are both **GRANTED**. Transcripts of the four depositions noted herein shall be made part of the record in this adjudicative hearing.
