A: My wife and I have lived here for over 4.5 years and were attracted to the huge panorama of agricultural land, stunningly pristine views and the wonderful wildlife of the Horse Heaven Hills...we feel blessed.

Q: Please describe your opinion on the effect this project will have on property value of your home and other homes in the area.

A: I am deeply concerned about the impact of the project on property values, damage to irreplaceable valuable agricultural land particularly at a time when our food supply is in question, while other less productive land areas are available. Of equal concern is the needless killing of precious and endangered wildlife while destroying their habitats with a project based on questionable science and technology. This is an irresponsible destruction of our children's rights to the wonderful land as it is. There are other places much more appropriate for this project much closer to the intended users of the energy. A majority of residents and local government officials don't want it here, and this needs to be respected. The overreach of distant government bodies must cease before a declaration of County Sovereignty, enforced by the local Sheriff if that becomes necessary.

Q: Please describe your opinion of any other issues or concerns you have about the project.

A: I was first licensed in real estate over 50 years ago and have done large scale land development. My experience and research indicate that property values will be harmed, development will be adversely affected. A large non-revokable bond of at least a billion dollars needs to be in place by the developer before this project is approved, to cure property owners' losses and damages already occurring from just the threat of this project.

The premise of wind and solar is deeply flawed. Solutions to energy needs exist that make much more scientific and ecological sense. The energy from this project is not for local residents, but to be sold to users hundreds of miles away, profiting others than the affected locals who have to live with the destructive elements. This represents government malevolence and corporate greed at its worst.
