2	I.	INTRODUCTION AND QUALIFICATIONS:
3	Q.	Please state your name, occupation, and business address.
4	A.	My name is Brynn Guthrie. I am the Landscape Architect / Visual Resources
5		Specialist. My business address is 1750 S Harbor Way Ste. 400 Portland OR 97201.
6	Q.	What are your job duties and responsibilities in that role?
7	A.	Managing visual resources tasks for state, federal and local permitting for renewable
8		energy and other infrastructure projects across the U.S.; conducting visual resource
9		assessments; identifying critical viewpoints for small to large energy developments,
10		coordinating field photography, managing visualization staff and reviewing
11		visualization work products.
12	Q.	What is your educational and professional background?
13	A.	A summary of my education and professional experience is included as
14		Attachment A.
15	Q.	When were you engaged in this matter?
16	A.	I was first engaged in the Horse Heaven project around November 2021.
17	II.	PURPOSE AND SUBJECT MATTER OF TESTIMONY:
18	Q.	For whom are you testifying and what is the purpose of your testimony?
19	A.	My testimony is offered on behalf of Scout Clean Energy. The purpose of my
20		testimony is to provide additional explanation and support for the visual/aesthetic
21		related sections of the Horse Heaven Wind Farm Application for Site Certification.
22	Q.	Are you sponsoring any portions of the Application for Site Certification for the
23		Horse Heaven Wind Farm? Please describe the sections of the application you
24		contributed to.
25	A.	Yes. I am sponsoring Section 4.2.3 concerning visual resources and effects.

- 8 for Site Certification, or, if not, did you direct and/or supervise their preparation?
- 9 A. The initial sections and appendices, including visual simulations, were prepared by
- other Tetra Tech staff before I joined the company in September 2021. Since that
- time, in my role as the Visual Resources Lead for Tetra Tech, I have supported, led
- and coordinated post-application materials prepared to assess visual effects. I am
- familiar with the content of the Sections and Appendices indicated and find them to
- be sound and sufficient.

- 17 A. Yes.
- 18 Q. Are the contents of these portions of those sections and appendices of the Application

1	Q.	Do you incorporate the facts and contents of these portions of those sections and
2		appendices of the Application for Site Certification as part of your testimony?
3	A.	Yes.
4	Q.	Are you able to answer questions under cross-examination regarding these portions of
5		those sections and appendices of the Application for Site Certification?
6	A.	Yes.
7	Q.	Do you sponsor the admission into evidence of these portions of those sections and
8		appendices of the Application for Site Certification?
9	A.	Yes.
10	Q.	Are there any modifications or clarifications to be made to these portions of those
11		portions of the Application for Site Certification that you are sponsoring?
12	A.	None beyond the modifications and supplementation provided in the Updated ASC.
13		In support of the Updated ASC, I oversaw revisions to eight of the Visualizations
14		developed for the Original Appendix Q, which the Applicant voluntarily undertook to
15		represent the most impactful (worst case) visibility conditions, that is, low-haze, clear
16		sky conditions. In addition, I am currently overseeing the development of three new
17		Visualizations from additional viewpoints in response to a Request from EFSEC.
18	Q.	How did you develop your contributions to those sections and appendices of the
19		Application for Site Certification?
20	A.	I reviewed the materials relevant to the Visual and Aesthetic Analysis and found them
21		to be sound and sufficient. After reviewing the Visual/Aesthetics Section and
22		Appendix in detail, I provided ongoing support of the visual and aesthetics analysis
23		through the post-submittal process, including overseeing revisions to visualizations as
24		described above. I also conducted a site visit to critical view areas discussed in the
25		Visual Section.

3	A.	The methodology is described within Section	4.2.3.2. Key concepts from the Bureau
4		of Land Management's (BLM) Visual Resour	ce Management program for identifying
5		impacts to visual resources were applied. Spec	eifically, key viewpoints were identified
6		based on an inventory of public resources from	n which the Project was anticipated to
7		be visible, and the visual contrast introduced by	by the Project compared to existing
8		conditions was evaluated. The level of visual	contrast anticipated for each identified
9		viewpoint is measured and described in the Ex	khibit.
