either had to get much bigger or do something else. While dairy farming, my wife and I were named national chair couple of the National Milk Producers Federation Young Cooperators Program. After that experience, I was appointed by the Idaho Governor to the Idaho Dairy Products Commission. When I was a couple years from selling the cows, I started getting my accounting degree from Boise State University. After graduating with an accounting degree in 1995, I took a commercial lending job and was in the banking until I retired in 2015.

Q: Please describe why you are testifying.

I am voluntarily supporting and coordinating with the local community non-profit organization Tri-City CARES, I am here to share my concerns about the impacts the Horse Heaven Hills Project will have on my home, property values, and the other homes in my neighborhood and other similarly situated neighborhoods in Tri-Cities. My neighbors and I support the work being done by Tri-Cities Cares.

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Q: Please state the address of your home and the name of the neighborhood in which it is located.

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A: My home address is 3516 W. 46th Ave., Kennewick, WA. We live in the Canyon Lakes Heights Subdivision. The south border of our subdivision is the southernmost developed property in Kennewick. This means that this proposed wind farm will nearly be in our backyard.

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Q: Please state how long you have lived at this address and why you chose to live
here.
A: I built our home in 2007 & 2008 and moved in December 2008. We chose this neighborhood because the homes here were holding their value or appreciating faster than other parts of town.
Q: Please describe your opinion on the effect this project will have on the property
value of your home and other homes in the area.
A: Because these ugly wind turbines will be very close to our home, there's no doubt in my mind that they will have a large negative effect on our property values. I definitely would not have built our home there if we would have had any idea that it was a possibility. The electricity won't even be used in our area.
Q: Please describe your opinion of any other issues or concerns you have about the project.
A: The electricity won't be used in our area, which would make them slightly justified
and I am concerned about the devaluation of our properties.
