5502 Astoria Road, West Richland, WA. I live in section 6 of Willamette Heights in West Richland. I'm just below the summit of Flat Top Hill.

Q: Please state how long you have lived at this address and why you chose to live here.

A: I've lived in the Tri Cities for 32 years and at my current address for 16 years. My wife and I moved here for more open space and the opportunity for a house with an extensive view.

Q: Please describe your opinion on the effect this project will have on the property value of your home and other homes in the area.

A: From my house, I would see approximately 50% of the proposed wind farm. The sight of approximately 125 six-hundred-foot-tall towers spinning on top of an existing 600-foot hill will be an overwhelming visual distraction. There will be constant blade flicker when the blades are spinning. This is both an impact on my quality of life, and in my opinion, will reduce the resale value of my property. A 24-mile eyesore on the western horizon is not a strong selling point. The photo below is from my back porch; the proposed wind farm would cover the entire ridge in the background. I believe the project will make the area less attractive to tourists, which would affect my employment.



Q: Please describe your opinion of any other issues or concerns you have about the project.

A: In addition to the personal impact to my property, the fact that the proposed wind farm is 3 miles from Kennewick, would only operate 25% of time, creates only about 10 permanent jobs, would not reduce any CO2 impacts, and is opposed by approximately 80% of the population makes approval completely irresponsible. This area is already a net exporter of green energy; we don't need this abortion of a project.
