Q: Please state how long have you lived at this address and why you chose to live here.

A: We purchased our undeveloped lot in 2017 and initiated construction of our retirement home in 2018, occupying the residence in January 2019. We chose the Tripple Vista area for the lot size, remote quiet farming theme and unobstructed panoramic views. We chose this site expecting to build our forever home and eventually retiring in this community of larger, well-maintained homes.

Q: Please describe your opinion on the effect this project will have on property value of your home and other homes in the area.

A: We feel the Horse Heaven Hills Wind Energy Project will negatively impact the desirability of this location and result in a corresponding and significant reduction to home and property values. The mass of the wind towers, obtrusive lighting pollution and long- term potential environmental impacts will have a lasting and undesirable impact on this growing area.

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Q: Please describe your opinion of any other issues or concerns you have about the project.

A: We are concerned about the obsessive pursuit of this project by the State of Washington Government given the lack of support by local PUD and other energy providers. We fear local residents will bear the negative aspects of the Windmills without deriving any benefit from the marginal energy they will contribute to the overall regional power needs.

We are concerned about the potential negative environmental impacts associated with wind towers in general and the lack of recyclable materials associated with their blades, gear oils, and materials of construction, given their marginal ability to contribute useable energy. The negative environmental impacts to wildlife and protected species seem to be a low consideration.

Further, due to low energy production from one windmill, more of them will become necessary to economically justify the project so the impacts become far greater.

We are concerned that this Energy project will place a future remediation mortgage on the taxpayers of Benton County and the State of Washington when non-generating windmills are abandoned in place, economically unrepairable and without a substantial client representing their repair. Similar to the impacts resulting from the State declaring bankruptcy during their abandonment of four unfinished Nuclear Power Plants.

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We are concerned about the loss of public access to surrounding areas when accessible lands are locked and public access is restricted by owners to prevent owner liable damages to the windmills located on surrounding properties.
