Q: Please describe why you are testifying.

A: I am qualified to testify because we have such a tremendously beautiful view off our south facing deck and I don't want that ruined by the HHH Wind Project. The Pacific Flyway for migratory birds crosses right over the Horse Heaven Hills and would be directly harmed by the proposed wind towers. Property values in Horn Rapids and surrounding neighborhoods would be severely impacted. I have supported and trust Tri-Cities CARES to represent me and my neighbors in this fight against a disastrously bad location for wind turbines.

Q: Please state the address of your home and the name of the neighborhood in which it is located.

A: 2717 Stonecreek Dr., Richland, WA 99354. Horn Rapids development.

Q: Please state how long you have lived at this address and why you chose to live here.

A: We have lived here for 5 years and chose this location because of the natural beauty and the quiet neighborhoods.

Q: Please describe your opinion on the effect this project will have on the property value of your home and other homes in the area.

A: The views at Horn Rapids are plentiful and stunningly beautiful. I have no doubt property values in our area would stagnate if the proposed HHH Wind Project becomes a reality. These 600-foot wind towers would be sited at the very tops of the ridge lines that we presently enjoy. The effect would be sheer horror.

Q: Please describe your opinion of any other issues or concerns you have about the project.

A: Other concerns about the proposed HHH wind turbines are:

- The close and distant views of the ridge lines would not only hurt my
  neighborhood, but the greater Tri-City and surrounding areas would also
  feel and see the effect. Such a massive industrial presence should not
  be located in the backyard of Washington State's 4th largest
  metropolitan area.
- I have concerns about the deteriorating air quality for everybody and the direct effects on the local farming, vineyards, and orchards.
- I have concerns also for our local bird and raptor populations.
- I also have concerns for the effectiveness of using wind turbines for generating electricity in this portion of America. Here they are 25% efficient, compared to 50% efficient in the Plains states. Additionally, on the hottest and coldest days of the year, there is no wind at all.
