Q: Please describe any opinion you have regarding the utility and reliance on the Hoen studies to the conclusions regarding the impacts of wind turbines on properties near the Horse Heaven Hills Wind and Solar Project.

A: It is my professional opinion that any statements suggesting or concluding that that the Horse Heaven Hills wind turbines will have no negative impact on property are highly questionable. These reports should not be utilized as a basis for decision-making for numerous reasons. I have not studied the Horse Heaven wind project in great detail, but I believe there are similarities based on a value loss study I conducted in proximity to a new transformer station in West Richland. Other studies I conducted show impacts on property values due to trees on adjacent property, houses being built
