In addition, based on its initial review, DNR Staff does not have any issues with the proposal to convert approximately 2.25 acres of DNR agricultural land to a graveled road and level stackyard (please see p. 7 of the EFSEC Staff Memorandum). However, DNR Staff does note that it will need to work with the Certificate Holder to ensure that the proposed layout of the road and staging area minimizes impacts to the existing agriculture lessee's current farming operations (including harvest) based on the terms of the existing lease in place.</p>
